We are excited to announce we have achieved and received our Modeshift Stars Bronze Accreditation.

Modeshift Stars is the national schools' awards scheme which was established to recognise schools which have demonstrated excellence in promoting and supporting sustainable travel. The scheme encourages schools to increase levels of sustainable travel in order to improve the health and well-being of their pupils.

The Eco Warriors alongside Miss Worrall and Mrs Simpson decided last year, as part of our Eco Schools Green Flag renewal process, chose 'Transport' as one of our new topics. We linked our work with Modeshift in order to achieve our award.
