

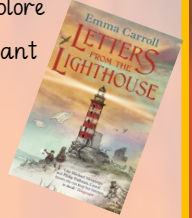
We'll meet again...

Year 6 Term 1 & 2



Welcome back to an exciting start to Y6 and this academic year.

Our topic this term will involve us engaging in the history of WW2. During the course of our topic, we will explore how the war affected citizens of Britain and Germany as well as discovering more about some incredibly important historical figures including Winston Churchill and Adolf Hitler. We will immerse ourselves in the challenges evacuees faced and how it really felt to be part of the Blitz! Our focus book for this term is Letters from the Lighthouse written by Emma Carroll.



Within our English lessons, we will be completing a setting description, diary entry, narrative, letters, non-chronological reports as well as spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In Spanish, the children will be learning phonics 4 and a selection of core vocabulary as well as their topic 'Do you have a pet?'



In DT, we will use textiles to design, create and evaluate a Christmas stocking. During our art lessons, we will be studying Pablo Picasso.

In our Science lessons, we will be learning about how light travels, exploring reflections and shadows.



In PSHE this term, we begin by exploring our safe hands, class charter and establishing expectations within our new classroom. We will be starting our new 'Jigsaw' scheme. Our first theme this term is 'Being me in my world. In term two the focus will be 'Celebrating difference'. The children will also be participating in Democracy Day, voting for their Student Council representative and Eco Warrior for their class. Our character education trait for this term is Self-Belief.



In RE, our topic is 'Understanding Christianity - God'. In term two, we explore the question 'Do you have to believe in God to be good?'. Within this topic, we study aspects of Humanism, Atheism and Buddhism.

Our Christian Values this term are 'Respect & Reverence' linked with 'Creation and Creativity'.

In term 2, we focus on 'Peace' linked with Friendship and Fellowship'.

Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school everyday. Our PE days this year are Tuesday and Wednesday. As the colder winter days draw in this term, please ensure that your child has appropriate outdoor P.E clothes including jogging bottoms and a jumper.



Throughout the autumn term, homework will consist of a palette of choice, where the children can choose a minimum of three exciting topic related pieces of 'Take Care' homework to complete and be handed in by Monday 16th October. In addition, the children will also receive a piece of grammar, reading and maths homework on a Friday, which will be due in on the following Friday. This is to begin preparation for secondary school. Please continue to practise timetables on TTRS and read at home everyday and record this in your reading diaries.
