During her visits, the children and staff have loved listening to her 'twisted' fairy tales, and they were fascinated by her own real-life adventure outlining how she became an award-winning author and illustrator.

This year's virtual workshop will include:

- Bethan delivering one of her most well-known fairy tales, exactly as it was intended
- An explanation of Bethan's illustration process, during which she will share both rough and final artworks
- An interactive, draw-along session led by Bethan
- A live Q&A session
