#### 3. Rock Your Tables:

#### 4. Score Points:

The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours, subject to a 60-minute limit). Winning classes in our school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.
