One of the most important things you can do with your child is read. Children will be sent home a grid with a series of tasks related to the Greeks which require additional research and offer the opportunity to show their understanding in a range of ways. We hope the children enjoy these tasks and take pride in the work they produce- we were astounded by some of the Victorian project work that was completed.
