KS2 2024/25 INTERESTED IN PLAYING AN INSTRUMENT?

Next academic year we will continue to work in partnership with Lincolnshire Music Service (LMS) to offer instrumental tuition in school for KS2 pupils. LMS have a **limited** number of spaces available for woodwind, brass, keyboard, guitar, and string lessons. If your child(ren) is/are interested, please follow the links below to apply directly with the music service. LMS will endeavour to accommodate all requests but must stress that spaces are limited. Please note that if your child has been taking lessons this year you should already have been contacted by LMS regarding next steps for academic year 2024/25.

The cost of music tuition from LMS for 2024/2025 is as follows:-

Lesson Type	Cost per Lesson *
Individual 15 minutes	£9.80
Individual 20 minutes	£13.00
Individual 30 minutes	£19.60
Shared 20 minute	£6.60
Shared 30 minute	£9.80

Instrument hire is also available on all instruments priced at flat-rate fee £18.00 per term (Autumn, Spring and Summer). Instrument hire is **FREE** for Free School Meals children and Looked After Children.

How to register for instrumental tuition?

In order to book instrumental tuition, register directly with SpeedAdmin here: https://uklincsmusicservice.speedadmin.dk/registration#/

Follow the link and register your child(ren) by:

- 1. Selecting the school your child(ren) attends
- 2. Selecting the instrument, you would like them to learn
- 3. Selecting the duration of the lesson required
- 4. Selecting instrument hire if necessary
- 5. Apply for a tuition voucher if your child(ren) is eligible to subsidised lessons
- 6. Submit your requests all at once after answering the supplementary questions and declared that you've read the terms and conditions.

Once you have registered, your child(ren) will be assigned an available tutor by LMS and you will be notified of the relevant details via email, as well as SpeedAdmin log in details.

How do I pay for the lessons?

Charges for lessons will be invoiced three times a year (Autumn, Spring and Summer) by Lincolnshire Music Service direct to the parent/carer. Payments are to be made in advance and payments are taken by the credit/debit card registered on SpeedAdmin. Lesson credits will be given at the end of term for any lessons not delivered by LMS and will be carried forward to the next term's balance. Please note monthly payment plans are available upon request.
