Our topic this term will involve us engaging in the history of WW2. During the course of our topic, we will explore how the war affected citizens of Britain and Germany as well as discovering more about some incredibly important historical figures including Winston Churchill and Adolf Hitler. We will immerse ourselves in the challenges evacuees faced and how it really felt to be part of the Blitz! Our focus book for this term is Letters from the Lighthouse written by Emma Carroll.

Within our English lessons, we will be completing a setting description, diary entry, narrative, leaflets, non-chronological reports as well as spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In Spanish, the children will be will learn the nouns





and determiners/definite articles for ten school subjects in Spanish... By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to talk about the subjects they like and dislike at school
