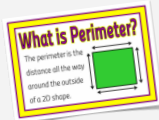


## Mathematics -

We'll continue our multiplication and division work, including multiplying and dividing 2 digit numbers!



We'll begin our measurement work with a hands on approach. We will learn to use a ruler accurately. Through practical lessons, we will become experts on finding the perimeter of shapes and measuring in millimetres, centimetres and meters.



## Computing and E-Safety -

We will be learning how to use a new stop frame animation application, this learning will end with us creating Bethan Woolvin style animated fairy tales.

Safer Internet Day is on 11th February 2025 and we will be exploring respect and relationships online. This will link to the British Value of mutual respect.



## Geography -

This term we are going to become super Geographers exploring North America. The children will encounter physical and human features across this incredible continent and end their learning by comparing Bourne to the bustling city of New York.



## Art -

During our workshop with the author Bethan Woolvin, we will recreate amazing illustrations from her collection of fractured fairy tale books- Little Red, Rapunzel and Hansel and Gretel.



## RE -

Our Christian Value for this term is **perseverance**. In RE, we are exploring the Christian worldview of the Trinity through our learning about Jesus' baptism and the Grace prayer.



## English -

We will explore a number of our favourite fairy tales, examining common themes and conventions. We will then use this to help us plan and write our own setting and character descriptions; and our very own fairy tales!



## DT -

We will design and make our very own pop up books, inspired by the book, 'Inside the Villains' and our wonderful character descriptions and narratives from our English learning.

We will be working on our dance and gymnastic skills.



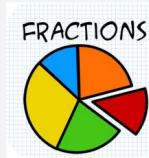
## PSHE -

## Mathematics -

We will explore fractions in the first of half of the term. Unit and non-unit fractions will be investigated and we will be looking into equivalence.

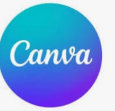


We will then move into our mass and capacity unit, understanding these terms will be our first step, before using a variety of units of measure to subtract and add.

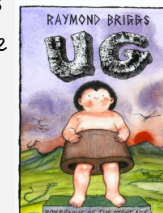
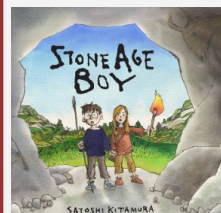
# Digging up the past. Year 3
