In term 4, we're looking forward to our learning adventures through exploring mountainous structures, locations, climates and lifestyle of those who call these majestic mountains home. Additionally, at the beginning of term 5 we are thrilled to be invited to an immersive inspirational talk from the fearless mountaineer Nigel Vardy (Mr Frostbite).

Exciting English

In Term 3, our children will explore the wonder and mystery of the moon Pandora from the science fiction film 'Avatar', where they will write engaging setting descriptions to entertain their peers. Following this, we will shift focus to writing a non-chronological report about the inspiring contributions of Katherine Johnson to NASA, highlighting her important role in space exploration.
